Underfloor sump Baufix 50



Application

Baufix 50 is a compact sump designed for the installation in foundation rafts or cellar floors. Together with the submersible motorised pump U 3 KS, it is suitable for the drainage of domestic wastewater from washbasins, sinks, showers and washing machines in cellars or lavatories. The floor drain in the cover of the sump protects the location against bigger floods. The introduction of wastewater from toilets and urinals is not permitted.

The pressure-resistant sump is placed into the pit without formwork; the pipes are connected and the sump embedded flush in concrete. The installation in areas subject to the groundwater flooding is permitted only along with additional measures (watertight concrete shell) as the connection between PE and concrete does not withstand pressing water.


In combination with the height-adjustable and rotatable cover made of plastic, the shaped sump neck permits a perfect level compensation at the installation site. Thus, the installation depth of the sump may vary between 45 and 71 cm. The arrangement of the combined inlets in the lower part of the sump permits installation in flat pits as well.

The swing-type check valve fitted in the works of the manufacturer prevents the reflux of the waste-water from the pressure pipe into the sump. The standard odour trap stops annoyance caused by offensive odour. The screw clamp with wing bolt in the container ensures ease of installation and maintenance of the pump.

For deeper installation depths or more powerful pumps, we recommend the use of Baufix 100 and Baufix 200.

The unit is in conformity with the specification of German / European standard DIN EN 12050.


Floor-level compensation

The cover with the round throat shoulder in the sump opening can be aligned vertically and rotationally. Thus, Baufix can be adapted to the effective upper edge of floor coverings or tiles laid at a later point. A profile sealing ring is used to seal the

space between sump and cover.

Odour trap

An odour trap is provided as a standard for the floor drain. The necessary siphon components belong to the scope of supply.

Technical data

Tank

Water-tight PE tank (40 to 55 l) with two combined inlets (DN 50 as sleeve / DN 100 as connecting piece) for space-saving connection, connecting piece for ventilation / cable conduit (DN 70) and connecting piece for pressure pipe DN 32 (PVC pipe, diam. 40 mm), integrated sump extension, level-compensating plastic frame, odour-tight plastic cover (screw fitted) and odour-tight floor drain. All junctions (tank / plastic cover frame and plastic cover frame / cover plate) are fitted with profiled seals.

Installation

Place the tank into the prepared pit or the existing chamber; align and shorten to the requested dimension, if and when required. Make the pipe connections, and encase the sump with concrete flush with the upper edge. Insulation, screed and flooring material are levelled by the height-adjustable plastic cover frame. Connect the special float for low switching heights and pressure pipe ports to the pump and join with the elastic pipe to the pre-mounted non-return valve. Pass the power cable of the pump through the venting / cable conduit up to the T piece provided by the customer. The outlet is then sealed odour-tight with the closing plug provided. If ventilation is not possible via the roof, the special ventilation system (see accessories / installation drawing) can be used.

Caution: It is not necessary to cut off the plug.

Scope of supply

Plastic tank to house a pump tested in keeping with German / European standard DIN EN 12050 with shaped connecting piece, shaped sump extension, level-compensating plastic cover frame with cover plate, odour trap for the floor drain, discharge branch with swing type-check valve and pressure pipe premounted in the tank, special float for lower switching heights, plug-in seal DN 50, closing plug for cable conduit (without pump).
